Dear Swim Team members and Parents:

SAS swim team members have made impressive improvements and will have the opportunity to display their swimming talent at the **final SAS Swim Meet of the year on April 18th** at the Puxi Aquatics Center. This meet is dedicated to raising money for mosquito nets to fight malaria. Swimmers' **entry fee of 35 rmb** will be donated to **World Swim Against Malaria** for the purchase of one anti-mosquito net. See further details below, or on the back of a printed copy of this form.

To register to swim, complete and return the form below with payment to the Aquatics Center or your coach by Wednesday **April 15th**. Swimmers may compete in up to **four (4) individual events and two (2) relays**. List your choice of events and list preference below. All swimmers will have an opportunity to swim in at least two of their choices. Coaches will make the final entry decisions for each swimmer. **Parents we need your help please sign up below!** Check your events online at: <http://aquaticscenter.saschina.org/> under the tab registrations & practice.

The swimmers will be age grouped for their events 15 & 0; 13-14; 11-12; 9 -10; and 8 & Under and scored according to their age groups; (based on their age the day of the meet). Swimmers will compete for event ribbons 1st -6th; and Medallions 1st - 3rd in Individual High Points. Relay events do not count toward individual point totals.

Events are as follows:

- 25m Butterfly and 50m Backstroke, Breaststroke & Freestyle (8 & Under)
- 100m IM (10 & Under)
- 200m IM (11 & Over)
- 50m Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke & Freestyle (9 & Over)
- 100m Backstroke, Breaststroke & Freestyle (9 & Over)
- 200m Freestyle (9 & Over) *Qualifying Time 3:00 minutes.*
- 100m Medley & Freestyle Relay (4 x 25m) (8 & Under)
- 200m Medley & Freestyle Relay (4 x 50m) (9 & Over)

- Warm-ups begin at 8:00 a.m. Events run from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Awards from 1:20 to 1:40 p.m.

Why fundraise against malaria?

1 - 3 million -people die of malaria each year, 70% of them are children under 5. The children that will die today from malaria would fill 7 jumbo jets. Malaria is the world's single largest killer of children and pregnant mothers.



[Net distributions](#)

The single most effective means of prevention is a mosquito net. Each long lasting insecticidal net (LLIN) – the net of choice - costs \$ 5. For each US\$100 raised, 20 nets will end up over heads and beds and save one child's life.

Malaria is entirely preventable and treatable. 1-3 million people need not die each year.
